AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled, 1 as amended, "An act providing for and reorganizing the 2 3 conduct of the executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the Executive Department thereof and the 4 5 administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, including the boards of trustees of State Normal 6 Schools, or Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, 7 reorganizing or authorizing the reorganization of certain 8 administrative departments, boards, and commissions; defining 9 the powers and duties of the Governor and other executive and 10 administrative officers, and of the several administrative 11 departments, boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the 12 13 salaries of the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive and administrative officers; providing for 14 the appointment of certain administrative officers, and of 15 all deputies and other assistants and employes in certain 16 departments, boards, and commissions; providing for the 17 regulation of pari-mutuel thoroughbred horse racing and 18 harness horse racing activities, imposing certain taxes and providing for the disposition of funds from pari-mutuel 19 20 tickets; and prescribing the manner in which the number and 21 22 compensation of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and commissions shall 23 be determined," in Commonwealth budget procedures, providing 24 for general appropriation bill compensation suspension. 25 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 26

- 6 cabinet officers and members of the General Assembly shall be
- 7 suspended until a general appropriation bill has been passed by
- 8 the General Assembly and signed by the Governor.
