## AN ACT

- The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6
- hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Short title.
- 9 This act shall be known and may be cited as the High-
- Definition Fiber Tracking (HDFT) for Veterans Act. 10
- 11 Section 2. Definitions.
- 12 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 13 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 14 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 15 "Brain scan equipment." Health care imaging equipment
- capable of identifying brain damage by graphic depiction of 16
- 17 individual nerve tracts.
- 18 "Department." The Department of Military and Veterans
- 19 Affairs of the Commonwealth.

- 1 "Eligible center." A health care facility designated by the
- 2 department to provide access to HDFT brain scans.
- 3 "HDFT." A brain scan employing High-Definition Fiber
- 4 Tracking technology.
- 5 Section 3. Military members and veterans.
- 6 (a) Diagnosis. -- Any military veteran or active duty or
- 7 reserve member of the United States Armed Forces or National
- 8 Guard who has symptoms of traumatic brain injury or
- 9 posttraumatic stress or evidence of combat-related concussion
- 10 shall be eligible to receive diagnostic treatment through the
- 11 use of the new HDFT technology using equipment located in this
- 12 Commonwealth.
- 13 (b) Eligible centers. -- The military veteran shall visit an
- 14 eligible center in order to begin the process for the use of the
- 15 diagnostic technology.
- 16 (c) Brain scan equipment. -- The equipment shall be purchased
- 17 or leased and provided to eligible centers to provide access to
- 18 HDFT technology throughout this Commonwealth.
- 19 Section 4. Regulations.
- 20 The department shall promulgate regulations for the
- 21 implementation of this act. The regulations shall allow for the
- 22 maximum number of military members and veterans to be able to
- 23 use the HDFT technology.
- 24 Section 5. Appropriation.
- 25 The sum of \$1,000,000, or as much thereof as may be
- 26 necessary, is appropriated to the department for the fiscal year
- 27 July 1, 2017, through June 30, 2018, to carry out the provisions
- 28 of this act.
- 29 Section 6. Funding.
- 30 (a) Eligible centers. -- Five hundred thousand dollars shall

- 1 be distributed by the department to all eligible centers
- 2 proportionally based on the number of veterans and active
- 3 members served at each eligible center. The money received by
- 4 each eligible center shall be used to pay for hardware and
- 5 software costs of the diagnostic technology and administrative
- 6 expenses of the eligible center directly related to the
- 7 provision of HDFT scans to military members and veterans.
- 8 (b) Brain scan equipment. -- Five hundred thousand dollars
- 9 shall be distributed by the department to ensure availability of
- 10 the diagnostic technology at eligible centers throughout this
- 11 Commonwealth.
- 12 Section 7. Effective date.
- 13 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
