

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 Petitioning the Congress of the United States to call a
2 convention of states limited to a congressional term limit
3 amendment to the Constitution of the United States.

4 RESOLVED (the Senate concurring), That the General Assembly
5 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania petition, under the
6 provisions of Article V of the Constitution of the United
7 States, the Congress of the United States to call a convention
8 of states limited to proposing an amendment to the Constitution
9 of the United States to limit the number of terms that a person
10 may be elected as a Member of the United States House of
11 Representatives and to set a limit on the number of terms that a
12 person may be elected as a Member of the United States Senate;
13 and be it further

14 RESOLVED, That the Chief Clerk of the House of
15 Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania transmit
16 copies of this application to the President and Secretary of the
17 Senate of the United States and to the Speaker, Clerk and

1 Judiciary Committee Chairman of the House of Representatives of
2 the United States and to the members of the Senate and House of
3 Representatives from this State, and also transmit copies of
4 this application to the presiding officers of each of the
5 legislative houses in the several states, requesting their
6 cooperation; and be it further

7 RESOLVED, That this application be considered as covering the
8 same subject matter as the applications from other states to
9 Congress to call a convention to set a limit on the number of
10 terms that a person may be elected to the Senate of the United
11 States and the House of Representatives of the United States,
12 and that this application shall be aggregated with the same for
13 the purpose of attaining the two-thirds of states necessary to
14 require Congress to call a limited convention on this subject,
15 but shall not be aggregated with any other applications on any
16 other subject; and be it further

17 RESOLVED, That this application constitutes a continuing
18 application in accordance with Article V of the Constitution of
19 the United States of America until the legislatures of at least
20 two-thirds of the several states have made applications on the
21 same subject; and be it further

22 RESOLVED, That a certified copy of this resolution be
23 transmitted by the Secretary of the Commonwealth to the
24 President of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the United
25 States House of Representatives, each member of the Pennsylvania
26 delegation to Congress and the presiding officers of each house
27 of the state legislatures, requesting their cooperation in
28 applying for an amendments convention limited to the subject
29 matter contemplated by this application.
