- Designating the month of May 2018 as "Necrotizing Fasciitis Awareness Month" and May 31, 2018, as "Necrotizing Fasciitis 2
- Awareness Day" in Pennsylvania. 3
- WHEREAS, Necrotizing fasciitis is an uncommon clinical 4
- disease that leads to the degradation of skin tissue and is 5
- commonly referred to as a flesh-eating bacteria or infection; 6
- 7 and
- WHEREAS, Necrotizing fasciitis was first defined within the 8
- medical community in 1883 by Jean Alfred Fournier and was 9
- described as a disease of unknown causes; and 10
- WHEREAS, Necrotizing fasciitis is a serious infection that 11
- may be caused by more than one type of bacteria, including Group 12
- A Streptococcus and Staphylococcus aureus, as well as bacteria 13
- naturally found in the intestines of healthy individuals; and 14
- WHEREAS, Necrotizing fasciitis can occur in any age group, 15
- but it is most commonly associated with surgical procedures; and 16
- WHEREAS, Necrotizing fasciitis may also be seen in people 17
- with diabetes mellitus, atherosclerotic vascular disease, 18

- 1 malignancy and hypertension; and
- WHEREAS, In rare occasions, necrotizing fasciitis may occur
- 3 following minor injuries to the skin caused by falls or cuts and
- 4 has been known to occur in healthy individuals; and
- WHEREAS, Necrotizing fasciitis can affect any part of the
- 6 body but most commonly involves the abdomen, arms, legs,
- 7 extremities and face, particularly around the eyes; and
- 8 WHEREAS, While progress has been made in understanding the
- 9 symptoms of necrotizing fasciitis and better diagnosing this
- 10 disease, there is still much to learn about necrotizing
- 11 fasciitis; and
- 12 WHEREAS, With increased research, the goals of discovering
- 13 the cause of the disease, improving treatment and finding a cure
- 14 are attainable; and
- 15 WHEREAS, It is of vital importance to raise public awareness
- 16 of necrotizing fasciitis to help promote early diagnosis, proper
- 17 management and treatment; and
- 18 WHEREAS, The House of Representatives desires to acknowledge
- 19 and honor both the survivors of necrotizing fasciitis as well as
- 20 those who have lost their battle to this disease; therefore be
- 21 it
- 22 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 23 month of May 2018 as "Necrotizing Fasciitis Awareness Month" and
- 24 May 31, 2018, as "Necrotizing Fasciitis Awareness Day" in
- 25 Pennsylvania.
