A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth
- of Pennsylvania, further providing for terms of members.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby resolves as follows:
- 5 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
- 6 Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
- 7 That section 3 of Article II be amended to read:
- 8 § 3. Terms of members.
- 9 (a) Senators shall be elected for the term of four years and
- 10 Representatives for the term of two years. Senators shall not be
- 11 eligible for election to more than three consecutive full terms
- 12 of office. Representatives shall not be eliqible for election to
- 13 more than six consecutive full terms of office.
- 14 (b) A Senator who has served the maximum number of
- 15 consecutive full terms may become a candidate for election to
- 16 the Senate at an election held not fewer than four years after

- 1 completion of the Senator's third consecutive full term of
- 2 office. A Representative who has served the maximum number of
- 3 consecutive full terms may become a candidate for election to
- 4 the House of Representatives at an election held not fewer than
- 5 two years after completion of the Representative's sixth
- 6 consecutive full term of office.
- 7 Section 2. Service in the General Assembly, whether the
- 8 service constitutes a full term of office or a partial term of
- 9 office, performed prior to the approval of the amendment of
- 10 section 3 of Article II of the Constitution of Pennsylvania by
- 11 the electorate shall not be considered in determining the
- 12 maximum number of consecutive full terms a Senator or
- 13 Representative may serve or in determining eligibility of a
- 14 Senator or Representative for election.
- 15 Section 3. (a) Upon the first passage by the General
- 16 Assembly of this proposed constitutional amendment, the
- 17 Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to
- 18 comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article
- 19 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the
- 20 required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in
- 21 which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after
- 22 passage of this proposed constitutional amendment.
- 23 (b) Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of this
- 24 proposed constitutional amendment, the Secretary of the
- 25 Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the
- 26 advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the
- 27 Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required
- 28 advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such
- 29 newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of
- 30 this proposed constitutional amendment. The Secretary of the

- 1 Commonwealth shall submit this proposed constitutional amendment
- 2 to the qualified electors of this Commonwealth at the first
- 3 primary, general or municipal election which meets the
- 4 requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of Article
- 5 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which occurs at least
- 6 three months after the proposed constitutional amendment is
- 7 passed by the General Assembly.
