- 8 Section 1. Sections 2911(d) and 2927(a) of Title 53 of the
- 9 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
- 10 § 2911. Submission of question for election of government study
- 11 commission.

- 13 (d) Duty of election board. -- At the next general or
- 14 municipal [or primary] election occurring not less than the 13th
- 15 Tuesday after the filing of the ordinance or the petition with
- 16 the county board of elections, it shall cause the appropriate
- 17 question to be submitted to the electors as other questions are
- 18 submitted under the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320),
- 19 known as the Pennsylvania Election Code.

- 2 § 2927. Limitation on enactment of ordinance or filing of petition.
- 4 (a) General rule.--[An] No ordinance may [not] be passed and
- 5 [a] no petition may [not] be filed for the election of a
- 6 government study commission pursuant to section 2911 (relating
- 7 to submission of question for election of government study
- 8 commission) while proceedings are pending under any other
- 9 petition or ordinance filed or passed under the authority of
- 10 this subpart nor [on the same question if it has been defeated]
- 11 within four years after an election has been held pursuant to
- 12 any such ordinance or petition passed or filed <u>under section</u>
- 13 2911 in which the question was defeated.

- 15 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
