A RESOLUTION

Designating October 2018 as "1918 Influenza Pandemic Remembrance 1 Month" in Pennsylvania to commemorate the 100th anniversary 2 of the 1918 influenza pandemic. 3 WHEREAS, Influenza pandemics occurred three times in the 4 previous century, and history and science suggest that the 5 United States and the world will face at least one pandemic in 6 7 this century; and WHEREAS, A pandemic can cause severe illness, death and 8 disruption throughout the country and the world, and outbreaks 9 can occur in many different locations all at the same time; and 10 WHEREAS, The 1918 influenza pandemic is recognized as one of 11 the most devastating diseases in human history with an estimated 12 50 million deaths worldwide; and 13 WHEREAS, It is estimated that approximately 500 million 14 people, or one-third of the world's population, became infected 15 with this virus and the high mortality in healthy people was a 16 unique feature of this pandemic; and 17 WHEREAS, More than 675,000 Americans are estimated to have 18

1 died during the pandemic, 50,000 of which were in Pennsylvania; 2 therefore be it
