7	Section 1. Section 3751(b)(1) and (2) of Title 75 of the
8	Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended and the
9	subsection is amended by adding a paragraph to read:
10	§ 3751. Reports by police.

12	(b) Furnishing copies of report
13	(1) [Police departments] <u>A police department</u> shall, upor
14	request, furnish a certified copy of the full report of the
15	police investigation of any vehicle accident to any person
16	involved in the accident, [his] the person's attorney or
17	insurer, and to the Federal Government, branches of the
18	military service, Commonwealth agencies, and to officials of

political subdivisions and to agencies of other states and nations and their political subdivisions.

<u>(1.1) If the request is made within 15 days of the</u>
<u>accident, the police department shall furnish an initial</u>
<u>written report of the accident at the same time the report is</u>
<u>delivered to the department under subsection (a). If the</u>
<u>initial report is not complete, a supplemental report shall</u>
<u>be submitted at a later date.</u>
(2) Except as provided in paragraph (3), the cost of

10 furnishing a copy of a report under this subsection shall not 11 exceed [\$15] <u>\$22</u>.
