- 9 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 10 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the

- 12 <u>"Committee." The Joint Revenue Estimation Committee</u>
- 13 <u>established under section 302</u> (relating to Joint Revenue
- 14 Estimation Committee).
- 15 <u>"Department." The Department of Revenue of the Commonwealth.</u>
- 16 <u>"Secretary."</u> The Secretary of Revenue of the Commonwealth.
- 17 § 302. Joint Revenue Estimation Committee.
- 18 (a) Establishment. -- The Joint Revenue Estimation Committee
- 19 <u>is established and shall be convened by the secretary no later</u>
- 20 than the first week of February following the beginning of each
- 21 <u>legislative session of the General Assembly.</u>
- 22 (b) Membership. -- The committee shall be comprised of the
- 23 following members:
- 24 (1) The secretary.
- 25 (2) The Secretary of the Budget.
- 26 (3) The chairperson of the Appropriations Committee of
- the Senate.
- 28 <u>(4) The minority chairperson of the Appropriations</u>
- 29 Committee of the Senate.
- 30 (5) The chairperson of the Appropriations Committee of

- 1 the House of Representatives.
- 2 (6) The minority chairperson of the Appropriations
- 3 Committee of the House of Representatives.
- 4 (7) One resident appointed by the Governor.
- 5 (8) One resident appointed by the President pro tempore
- of the Senate.
- 7 (9) One resident appointed by the Speaker of the House
- 8 of Representatives.
- 9 (10) One resident appointed by the Minority Leader of
- the Senate.
- 11 (11) One resident appointed by the Minority Leader of
- 12 <u>the House of Representatives.</u>
- 13 (12) The Director of the Independent Fiscal Office as an
- ex officio member.
- 15 (c) Staff. -- The committee shall be staffed by employees of
- 16 the department who shall prepare any documents requested by a
- 17 member of the committee.
- 18 § 303. Meetings.
- The committee shall meet at least once a month to discuss
- 20 changes in the revenue collected by the Commonwealth during the
- 21 <u>current month and the fiscal year compared to the most recently</u>
- 22 released estimate made by the committee.
- 23 § 304. Revenue estimates.
- 24 (a) Preparation of estimates. -- Twice each fiscal year, by
- 25 December 16 and May 15, the committee shall prepare a joint
- 26 <u>estimate of revenue for the General Fund. The estimate shall</u>
- 27 include revenue the Commonwealth can anticipate collecting for
- 28 the current fiscal year and the ensuing fiscal year.
- 29 (b) Approval. -- No revenue estimate may be approved without
- 30 being approved by 11 members of the committee. The following

- 1 shall apply:
- 2 (1) If, prior to final adjournment of any regular
- 3 legislative session of the General Assembly, a law is enacted
- 4 providing for additional or less money to be deposited into
- 5 the General Fund, the committee shall prepare a joint
- 6 estimate of those revenues.
- 7 (2) The committee may release a revised revenue estimate
- 8 90 days following the release of an approved revenue estimate
- 9 <u>under subsection (a) only if the estimate is approved by 11</u>
- members of the committee.
- 11 (c) Submission. -- The committee shall submit the revenue
- 12 <u>estimates to the Governor, General Assembly, State Treasurer and</u>
- 13 <u>Independent Fiscal Office.</u>
- 14 (d) Failure to approve estimate. -- If the committee fails to
- 15 approve a revenue estimate under this section, the Governor and
- 16 the General Assembly shall utilize the revenue estimates of the
- 17 Independent Fiscal Office for approving General Fund
- 18 expenditures.
- 19 § 305. Initial revenue estimate.
- The secretary shall convene the committee, which shall
- 21 release a revenue estimate for the current fiscal year and
- 22 ensuing fiscal year within 30 days of the effective date of this
- 23 <u>section</u>. If the committee is unable to agree on a revenue
- 24 <u>estimate under section 304 (relating to revenue estimates)</u>, the
- 25 Governor and the General Assembly shall use a revenue estimate
- 26 from the Independent Fiscal Office to enact General Fund
- 27 expenditures for the ensuing fiscal year.
- 28 <u>§ 306.</u> Revenue estimate error rates.
- The committee shall provide a public report on the error
- 30 rates of the previous fiscal year revenue estimates no later

- 1 than October 1 of the following fiscal year. Revenue error rates
- 2 for each tax may not be greater than 3%. If an error rate is
- 3 greater than 3%, the committee shall develop a new model to
- 4 ensure error rates remain under 3%.
- 5 § 307. Presentation of revenue estimate.
- 6 (a) General rule. -- The December revenue estimate prepared
- 7 under section 304(a) (relating to revenue estimates) shall be
- 8 included in the presentation of the budget to the General
- 9 Assembly by the Governor under section 619 of the act of April
- 10 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of
- 11 1929.
- 12 (b) Contents. -- The revenue estimate submitted with the
- 13 <u>budget shall include all of the following:</u>
- 14 (1) The committee error rate.
- 15 (2) The highest revenue the Commonwealth could collect
- the following fiscal year based on the committee error rate.
- 17 (3) The lowest revenue the Commonwealth could collect
- 18 the following fiscal year based on the committee error rate.
- 19 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
