Excellence; in vocational education, providing for

utilization of credits; and providing for classification of

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- 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 11 hereby enacts as follows:
- 12 Section 1. Section 1549.1(1) of the act of March 10, 1949
- 13 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is
- 14 amended by adding a paragraph to read:
- 15 Section 1549.1. Commission for Agricultural Education
- 16 Excellence.--* * *
- 17 (1) The commission shall have all the following powers and
- 18 duties:
- 19 * * *
- 20 (6) Issue quidelines and update the guidelines every five
- 21 years to identify the circumstances when a student who

- 1 successfully completes an academic course, program or activity
- 2 for credit may apply the credit toward completion of an
- 3 agriculture education program.
- 4 * * *
- 5 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
- 6 Section 1856. Utilization of Credits. -- The Department of
- 7 Education shall issue quidelines and update the quidelines every
- 8 five years to identify the circumstances when a student who
- 9 successfully completes a course, program or activity in science,
- 10 technology, engineering or mathematics for credit may apply the
- 11 credit toward the completion of a course, program or activity
- 12 offered by any area vocational-technical school, technical
- 13 institute or vocational school or department.
- 14 Section 3. The act is amended by adding an article to read:
- 15 <u>ARTICLE XIX-H</u>
- 16 CLASSIFICATION OF PROGRAM CODE
- 17 Section 1901-H. Definitions.
- The following words and phrases when used in this article
- 19 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 20 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 21 "Classification of program code." A numerical coding of
- 22 instructional programs developed by the United States Department
- 23 of Education used to identify vocational programs.
- 24 "Department." The Department of Education of the
- 25 Commonwealth.
- 26 "Public school entity." A school district, charter school,
- 27 regional charter school, cyber charter school, intermediate unit
- 28 or area vocational-technical school.
- 29 <u>Section 1902-H. Establishment or renewal of classification of</u>
- 30 <u>program code</u>.

- 1 The department shall establish a standard application form
- 2 for a public school entity seeking approval to establish or
- 3 renew a classification of program code. The form shall be
- 4 <u>published on the department's publicly accessible Internet</u>
- 5 website. The form shall require the following information:
- 6 (1) The name of the public school entity seeking
- 7 approval to establish or renew a classification of program
- 8 <u>code</u>.
- 9 (2) The title of the classification of program code.
- 10 (3) The occupational competency area of the
- 11 classification of program code.
- 12 <u>(4) A description of the classification of program code.</u>
- 13 (5) A list of skills that a student must attain in order
- to complete the classification of program code.
- 15 (6) Evidence of financial support for the classification
- of program code from the public school entity.
- 17 (7) Any additional information that the department deems
- 18 <u>necessary to determine whether to approve or disapprove of</u>
- the classification of program code.
- 20 <u>Section 1903-H. Submission of applications.</u>
- No later than January 31 of each year, a public school entity
- 22 may submit the application under section 1902-H to the
- 23 department for approval or disapproval of a classification of
- 24 program code.
- 25 <u>Section 1904-H. Notice of approval or denial of applications.</u>
- 26 (a) Notice. -- No later than May 31 of the year the department
- 27 <u>receives an application under section 1902-H, the department</u>
- 28 shall notify a public school entity which submitted the
- 29 application whether the department approved or denied the
- 30 application.

- 1 (b) Posting. -- No later than June 15 of the year the
- 2 department approved the application under subsection (a), the
- 3 department shall post the classification of program code on its
- 4 publicly accessible Internet website.
- 5 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
