A RESOLUTION

Designating November 7, 2019, as "Victims of Communism Memorial 1 Day" in Pennsylvania. 2 WHEREAS, The year 2017 marked 100 years since the Bolshevik 3 Revolution in Russia resulting in the world's first communist 4 regime under Vladimir Lenin, which led to decades of oppression 5 and violence under communist regimes throughout the world; and 6 WHEREAS, Based on the philosophy of Karl Marx, communism has 7 proven incompatible with the ideals of liberty, prosperity and 8 dignity of human life and has given rise to such infamous 9 totalitarian dictators as Joseph Stalin, Mao Zedong, Ho Chi 10 Minh, Pol Pot, Nicolae Ceaușescu, the Castro brothers and the 11 Kim dynasty; and 12 WHEREAS, President Donald Trump declared November 7, 2018, as 13 the "National Day for the Victims of Communism," condemning 14 communism as a political philosophy "incompatible with liberty, 15 prosperity and the dignity of human life"; and 16 WHEREAS, The bipartisan United States Congressional Victims 17

of Communism Caucus stated publicly in 2018 that "Marx's defenders often say he cannot be held accountable for what communist regimes did long after his life and death; but Marxist dictators who massacred their own people were applying communist ideology to political practice"; and

6 WHEREAS, Communist regimes worldwide have killed more than 7 100 million people and subjected countless others to the worst 8 and widest-spread human rights abuses known to history, with 9 victims representing many different ethnicities, creeds and 10 backgrounds; and

WHEREAS, Through false promises of equality and liberation, communist regimes have, as a matter of government policy, robbed their own citizens of the rights of freedom of religion, freedom of speech and freedom of association through coercion, brutality and fear; and

WHEREAS, Many victims of communism were persecuted as political prisoners for speaking out against these regimes and others were killed in genocidal, state-sponsored purges; and WHEREAS, In addition to violating basic human rights, communist regimes have suppressed freedom of conscience, cultural life and self-determination movements in more than 40 nations; and

WHEREAS, The Victims of Communism Memorial Foundation in Washington, DC, a nonprofit organization authorized by a unanimous act of the United States Congress, educates people about the ideology, history and legacy of communism and honors those who have suffered and died under communist regimes; therefore be it
