- 2 Convention for proposing an amendment pursuant to Article V
- of the Constitution of the United States limited to proposing
- an amendment that limits the number of justices on the
- 5 Supreme Court of the United States.
- 6 WHEREAS, The Founders of our nation empowered State
- 7 legislators to be quardians of liberty against future abuses of
- 8 power by the Federal Government; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The number of Supreme Court justices has fluctuated
- 10 from 7 justices at its smallest point to 10 justices at its
- 11 largest point; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The United States Constitution does not specify the
- 13 number of justices that should sit on the Supreme Court; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Currently the number of Supreme Court justices is
- 15 specified in the Judiciary Act of 1789; and
- 16 WHEREAS, The Congress of the United States can easily amend
- 17 the act to add or subtract justices to increase the power of the
- 18 majority party or for other partisan purposes; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Presidents and members of Congress have threatened

- 1 to pack the court for the purpose of achieving a political end;
- 2 and
- 3 WHEREAS, The Supreme Court was not meant to be a tool for a
- 4 partisan Congress to use to increase their power; therefore be
- 5 it
- 6 RESOLVED (the Senate concurring), That the General Assembly
- 7 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby apply to Congress
- 8 under the provisions of Article V of the Constitution of the
- 9 United States for the calling of a convention limited to
- 10 proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States
- 11 to limit the number of Supreme Court justices to nine; and be it
- 12 further
- 13 RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be transmitted by
- 14 the Secretary of the Commonwealth to the President of the United
- 15 States Senate, the Speaker of the United States House of
- 16 Representatives, each member of Congress from Pennsylvania and
- 17 to the presiding officers of each house of the state
- 18 legislatures requesting their cooperation in applying for a
- 19 convention limited to the subject matter contemplated by this
- 20 application.
