

A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the week of March 15 through 21, 2020, as "National
2 Surveyors Week" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, The role of the surveyor has been, and remains, of
4 vital importance in the development of the United States and to
5 our private property rights; and

6 WHEREAS, Surveying requires both fieldwork and indoor work in
7 order to measure, maintain, monitor, verify, validate and
8 regulate boundaries of land, economic assets and other
9 properties; and

10 WHEREAS, Since the colonial era, surveyors have been
11 statesmen, leaders in the community and influential citizens;
12 and

13 WHEREAS, Former surveyors include George Washington, Thomas
14 Jefferson, John Adams and Abraham Lincoln; and

15 WHEREAS, Surveyors remain essential to the development of the
16 United States and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania today; and

17 WHEREAS, The surveying profession requires special education,

1 training, knowledge of mathematics and physical and applied
2 sciences and legal requirements for evidence; and

3 WHEREAS, "National Surveyors Week" is an opportunity to
4 recognize the historic contributions of surveying and appreciate
5 the new technologies that are constantly modernizing the
6 profession; and

7 WHEREAS, "National Surveyors Week" has been celebrated
8 annually since 1984 during the week in March following the third
9 Sunday; therefore be it

10 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
11 week of March 15 through 21, 2020, as "National Surveyors Week"
12 in Pennsylvania.
