A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the month of May 2020 as "Junior Achievement Month"
2 in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Junior Achievement is the world's largest

7 WHEREAS, More than 6,000 business, community and parent
8 volunteers touch the lives of more than 200,000 students in
9 kindergarten through grade 12 in public and private school
10 systems in this Commonwealth with a message of hope and
11 prosperity for the future and prepare students to be the
12 workers, leaders and educated consumers of tomorrow; and

13 WHEREAS, Junior Achievement programs help prepare young
14 people for the real world by showing them how to generate wealth
15 and effectively manage it, create jobs which make their
16 communities more robust and apply entrepreneurial thinking in
17 the workplace; and

1 WHEREAS, Junior Achievement empowers young people to own
2 their economic success; and

3 WHEREAS, Junior Achievement believes in the boundless
4 potential of young people, is committed to the principles of
5 market-based economics and entrepreneurship and is passionate
6 about what individuals do while practicing honesty, integrity
7 and excellence; and

8 WHEREAS, Junior Achievement respects the talents, creativity,
9 perspectives and backgrounds of all individuals; and

10 WHEREAS, Junior Achievement believes in the power of
11 partnership and collaboration and has conviction in the
12 educational and motivational impact of relevant, hands-on
13 learning; and

14 WHEREAS, Junior Achievement sustains our democracy by
15 strengthening communities with proven programs that focus on
16 workforce development, entrepreneurship and financial literacy;

18 WHEREAS, Junior Achievement commemorates the 81st anniversary
19 of its founding in this Commonwealth in 2020; therefore be it

20 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
