A RESOLUTION

Designating the month of October 2020 as "Archives Month" in 1 Pennsylvania. 2 WHEREAS, The historical documents and records of our nation 3 and our Commonwealth provide a crucial link to our past; and 4 WHEREAS, The House of Representatives recognizes the growing 5 importance of maintaining its own legislative, committee and 6 individual member records for posterity; and 7 WHEREAS, For nearly 40 years, the House of Representatives 8 Archives has served as the official archival repository for the 9 records of elected members, committees and administrative 10 agencies of that body; and 11 WHEREAS, These historical records and documents, if not man 12 13 professionally collected, cataloged and preserved by dedicated archivists and staff and housed in a secure location, would be 14 lost to future generations of our residents; and 15 WHEREAS, The House of Representatives Archives seeks to share 16 the valuable historical information and documents in its 17

1 holdings with researchers, legislators, staff members and the

WHEREAS, Numerous records are available to researchers, 3 4 legislators, staff members and the public, including the collection of House Committee records from 1971 to the present, 5 an interactive online historical, biographical directory of 6 members dating from 1840 to the present and an extensive 7 collection of more than 150 oral history interviews with 8 9 legislators, which allows former representatives to record their experiences and discuss their legislation while they served in 10 the House of Representatives, providing scholars and residents 11 alike with the ability to consult and utilize these historically 12 13 valuable resources; therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the month of October 2020 as "Archives Month" in Pennsylvania; and he it further
