## AN ACT

Amending the act of July 23, 1970 (P.L.563, No.195), entitled 1 "An act establishing rights in public employes to organize 2 and bargain collectively through selected representatives; defining public employes to include employes of nonprofit 3 4 organizations and institutions; providing compulsory 5 mediation and fact-finding, for collective bargaining 6 7 impasses; providing arbitration for certain public employes for collective bargaining impasses; defining the scope of 8 collective bargaining; establishing unfair employe and employer practices; prohibiting strikes for certain public 9 10 employes; permitting strikes under limited conditions; 11 providing penalties for violations; and establishing 12 procedures for implementation," in strikes, providing for 13 health care benefits during strikes. 14

15 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

16 hereby enacts as follows:

17 Section 1. The act of July 23, 1970 (P.L.563, No.195), known

- 18 as the Public Employe Relations Act, is amended by adding a
- 19 section to read:
- 20 <u>Section 1006.1. A public employer may not discontinue a</u>
- 21 public employe's health care benefits during the period that the
- 22 <u>public employe is engaged in a strike.</u>
- 23 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
