## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), entitled "An
- act to consolidate, editorially revise, and codify the public
- welfare laws of the Commonwealth," in public assistance,
- 4 further providing for persons eligible for medical
- 5 assistance.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Section 441.1 of the act of June 13, 1967
- 9 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Human Services Code, is amended by
- 10 adding a subsection to read:
- 11 Section 441.1. Persons Eligible for Medical Assistance.--\* \*
- 12. \*
- 13 (e) The department shall establish an enrollment process for
- 14 <u>individuals eliqible for medical assistance under this section</u>
- 15 to enroll in an individual plan approved by the department and
- 16 offered as part of the Commonwealth's approved Title XIX State
- 17 Plan as follows:
- 18 (1) The enrollment process shall include information for the
- 19 individual that, except as otherwise provided for under

- 1 paragraph (4), the individual shall remain enrolled with the
- 2 <u>same plan for one year.</u>
- 3 (2) After an individual eligible for medical assistance
- 4 under this section enrolls in a plan approved by the department
- 5 <u>under the Commonwealth's approved Title XIX State Plan, the</u>
- 6 <u>individual shall remain enrolled in the individual plan until</u>
- 7 the individual's redetermination period, but for at least 12
- 8 months unless the individual qualifies for an exemption under
- 9 paragraph (4), or until such time as the individual is no longer
- 10 <u>eliqible</u> for medical assistance.
- 11 (3) The department shall notify the individual eligible for
- 12 <u>medical assistance under this section about the ability at the</u>
- 13 time of redetermination to change the plan in which the
- 14 <u>individual</u> is enrolled for services offered under the
- 15 <u>Commonwealth's approved Title XIX State Plan.</u>
- 16 (4) The department may grant an exemption to the limitation
- 17 on changing plans under this section only if the exemption
- 18 matches standard practices for health insurance plans approved
- 19 by the Insurance Department under the insurance laws of this
- 20 Commonwealth, including, but not limited to:
- 21 (i) a qualifying life event;
- (ii) a relocation of the individual to a region which is not
- 23 served by the selected Medicaid managed care organization; or
- 24 (iii) a verified health condition which requires treatment
- 25 by a provider not currently participating in the Medicaid
- 26 managed care organization.
- 27 (5) The department shall approve the exemption for an
- 28 <u>individual based on applicable Federal regulations regarding</u>
- 29 <u>enrollment or on the approved State plan.</u>
- 30 (6) Nothing in this section shall be construed to remove an

- 1 <u>individual's eliqibility for medical assistance for missing the</u>
- 2 <u>enrollment period provided in this subsection.</u>
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
