Designating October 10, 2020, as "Put the Brakes on Fatalities 1 Day" in Pennsylvania. 2 3 WHEREAS, The number of highway deaths on Pennsylvania roads totaled 1,059 in 2019, the lowest number since recordkeeping 4 5 began in 1928; and 6 WHEREAS, There are many controllable causes of traffic fatalities, including excessive speed, use of alcohol and drugs, 7 8 inexperience, carelessness and distracted driving; and 9 WHEREAS, The National Society of Professional Engineers, the National Academy of Forensic Engineers, the Institute of 10 Transportation Engineers Expert Witness Council and a coalition 11 12 of government agencies have teamed up to focus national public 13 awareness on October 10, 2020, on the cause of traffic fatalities and the need to reduce the number of traffic 14 fatalities; and 15

2	(1) driving courteously and defensively;
3	(2) knowing the rules of the road for their method of

8	(5) avoiding talking or text messaging on cell phones
9	while driving;
