Amending Title 58 (Oil and Gas) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 1 Statutes, in development, further providing for relationship 2 to solid waste and surface mining. 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4 hereby enacts as follows: 5 Section 1. Section 3273.1(a) and (b) of Title 58 of the 6 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read: 7 § 3273.1. Relationship to solid waste and surface mining. 8 (a) General rule.--[The obligation to] An owner or operator 9 of a well shall obtain a permit and post a bond under Articles 10 III and V of the act of July 7, 1980 (P.L.380, No.97), known as 11 the Solid Waste Management Act, and [to] provide public notice 12 under section 1905-A(b)(1)(v) of the act of April 9, 1929 13 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929, for 14 any pit, impoundment, method or facility employed for the 15 disposal, processing or storage of residual wastes generated by 16 the drilling of an oil or gas well or from the production of 17 wells which is located on the well site .[, shall be considered 18

to have been satisfied if the owner or operator of the well 1 meets the following conditions: 2 (1) the well is permitted under the requirements of 3 section 3211 (relating to well permits) or registered under 4 section 3213 (relating to well registration and 5 identification); 6 (2) the owner or operator has satisfied the financial 7 security requirements of section 3225 (relating to bonding) 8 by obtaining a surety or collateral bond for the well and 9 well site; and 10 (3) the owner or operator maintains compliance with this 11 chapter and applicable regulations of the Environmental 12 Ouality Board.] 13 Noncoal surface mining. -- Obligations under the act of 14 (b) December 19, 1984 (P.L.1093, No.219), known as the Noncoal 15 Surface Mining Conservation and Reclamation Act, or a regulation 16 promulgated under the Noncoal Surface Mining Conservation and 17 Reclamation Act, for any borrow area where minerals are 18 extracted solely for the purpose of oil and gas well 19 development, including access road construction, shall be 20 considered to have been satisfied if the owner or operator of 21 the well meets the following conditions [imposed under 22 subsection (a)(1) and (2) and]: 23 (1) the well is permitted under the requirements of 24 section 3211 (relating to well permits) or registered under 25 section 3213 (relating to well registration and 26 identification); 27 (2) the owner or operator has satisfied the financial 28 security requirements of section 3225 (relating to bonding) 29 by obtaining a surety or collateral bond for the well and 30
