AN ACT

Amending Title 27 (Environmental Resources) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in environmental protection, providing for single-use plastic straw prohibition; and imposing civil penalties.

- 7 Section 1. Title 27 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes is amended by adding a chapter to read:

- 1 § 4301. Purpose.
- 2 The intent of this chapter is to reduce the adverse
- 3 environmental impact of single-use plastic straws.
- 4 § 4302. Definitions.
- 5 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 6 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 7 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 8 "Department." The Department of Environmental Protection of
- 9 the Commonwealth.
- 10 "Food establishment." All sales outlets, stores, shops or
- 11 other places of business located within this Commonwealth which
- 12 operate primarily to sell or convey food directly to the
- 13 ultimate consumer, which food is predominately contained,
- 14 wrapped or held in or on packaging. The term includes any place
- 15 where food is prepared, mixed, cooked, baked, smoked, preserved,
- 16 bottled, packaged, handled, stored, manufactured and sold or
- 17 offered for sale, including, but not limited to, any fixed or
- 18 mobile restaurant, drive-in, coffee shop, cafeteria, short order
- 19 cafe, delicatessen, luncheonette, grill, sandwich shop, soda
- 20 fountain, tavern, bar, cocktail lounge, nightclub, roadside
- 21 stand, prepared food take-out place, industrial feeding
- 22 <u>establishment</u>, catering kitchen, commissary, grocery store,
- 23 public food market, food stand or similar place in which food or
- 24 drink is prepared for sale or for service on the premises or
- 25 <u>elsewhere</u>, and any other establishment or operation, including
- 26 homes, where food is processed, prepared, stored, served or
- 27 provided for the public for charge.
- 28 "Retailer." A person that purchases or receives products
- 29 from any source for the purpose of sale to a consumer.
- 30 "Single-use plastic straw." A single-use, disposable tube

- 1 made predominantly of plastic derived from either petroleum or a
- 2 biologically based polymer, such as corn or other plant sources,
- 3 used to transfer a beverage from a container to the mouth of the
- 4 person drinking the beverage. The term does not include a straw
- 5 made from nonplastic materials, including, but not limited to,
- 6 paper, pasta, sugar cane, wood or bamboo.
- 7 § 4303. Prohibition.
- 8 (a) Food establishment. -- A food establishment is prohibited
- 9 from selling, giving or providing single-use plastic straws
- 10 except on the specific request of a customer.
- 11 (b) Retailer.--A retailer is prohibited from selling, giving
- 12 or providing single-use plastic straws except on the specific
- 13 request of a customer.
- 14 § 4304. Complaints.
- The department shall prescribe a procedure for a person to
- 16 <u>file a complaint with the department for a violation of this</u>
- 17 chapter.
- 18 § 4305. Compliance.
- 19 The department shall develop and maintain a publicly
- 20 accessible Internet website with all of the following:
- 21 (1) A description of the information necessary to comply
- 22 with the prohibition under section 4303 (relating to
- 23 prohibition).
- 24 (2) A description of the procedure under section 4304
- 25 (relating to complaints) to file a complaint with the
- department for a violation of the prohibition under this
- 27 chapter.
- 28 § 4306. Regulations.
- The department may promulgate rules and regulations necessary
- 30 to implement the provisions of this chapter.

- 1 § 4307. Penalties.
- 2 (a) Imposition. -- The department may impose a civil penalty
- 3 in the following amounts for a violation of this chapter:
- 4 (1) For a first violation, \$500.
- 5 (2) For a second violation, \$1,000.
- 6 (3) For a third or subsequent violation, \$2,000.
- 7 (b) Payment. -- Any civil penalty collected under subsection
- 8 (a) shall be paid to the department.
- 9 (c) Local law. -- This chapter shall preempt any ordinance or
- 10 resolution passed or adopted by any political subdivision that
- 11 is effective on or before or after the effective date of this
- 12 chapter to the extent that the ordinance or resolution conflicts
- 13 or is inconsistent with the provisions of this chapter.
- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
