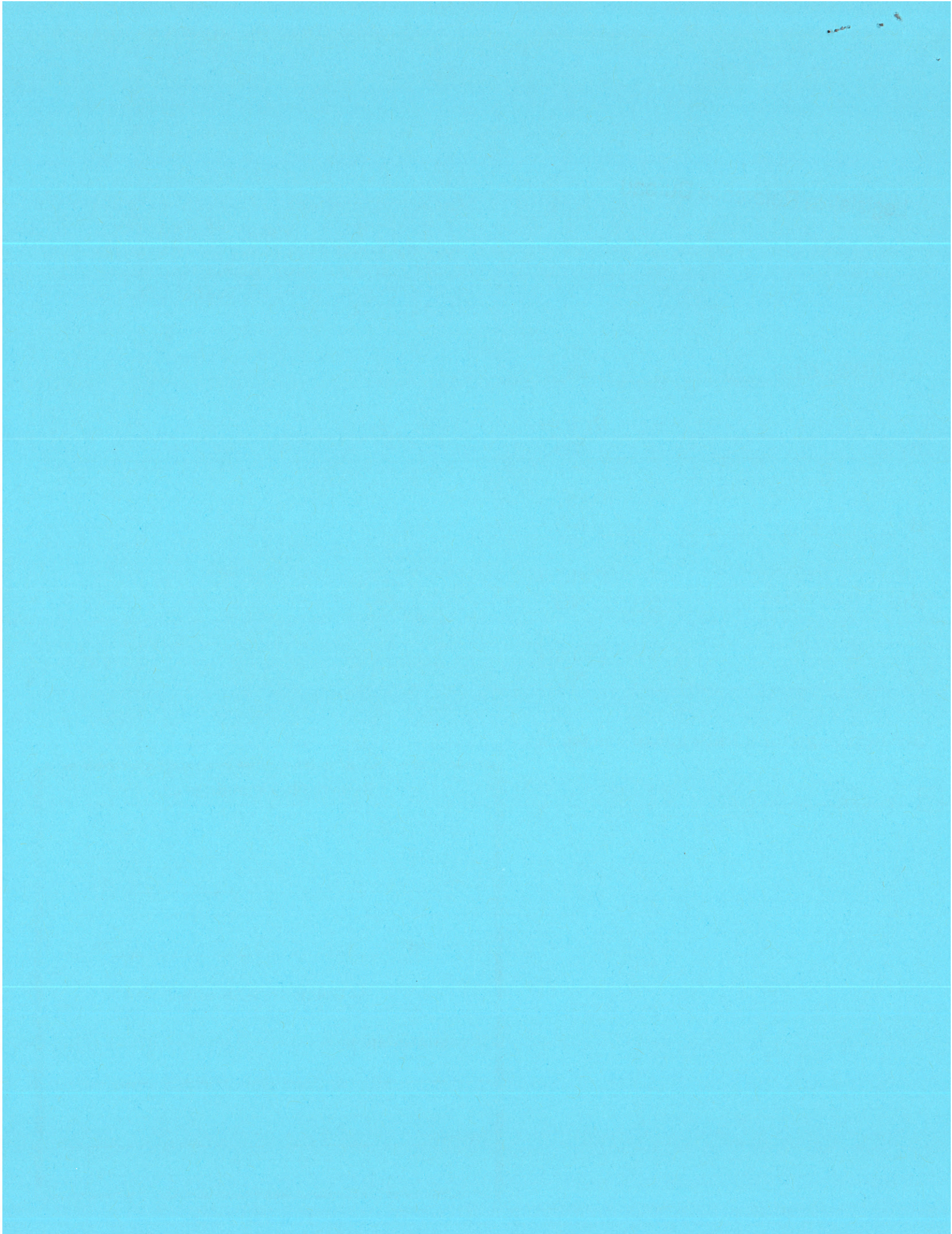

## AN ACT

1 Amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), entitled "An  
2 act relating to tax reform and State taxation by codifying  
3 and enumerating certain subjects of taxation and imposing  
4 taxes thereon; providing procedures for the payment,  
5 collection, administration and enforcement thereof; providing  
6 for tax credits in certain cases; conferring powers and  
7 imposing duties upon the Department of Revenue, certain  
8 employers, fiduciaries, individuals, persons, corporations  
9 and other entities; prescribing crimes, offenses and  
10 penalties," in tax for education, further providing for  
11 transfers to Public Transportation Assistance Fund.

12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
13 hereby enacts as follows:

14 Section 1. Section 281.2 of the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6,  
15 No.2), known as the Tax Reform Code of 1971, is amended by  
16 adding a subsection to read:

17 Section 281.2. Transfers to Public Transportation Assistance  
18 Fund.--\* \* \*

19 (f) Notwithstanding any other provision of the law, for  
20 fiscal years 2020-2021 and 2021-2022, funding received from the  
21 Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act of 2020 (P.L.  
22 116-136, 134 Stat. 281), referred to as the CARES Act, shall

1 qualify as local matching funds.

2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
