## AN ACT

Amending the act of June 27, 2006 (1st Sp.Sess., P.L.1873, No.1), entitled "An act providing for taxation by school districts, for the State funds formula, for tax relief in 3 first class cities, for school district choice and voter 4 participation, for other school district options and for a 5 task force on school cost reduction; making an appropriation; 6 prohibiting prior authorized taxation; providing for 7 installment payment of taxes; restricting the power of 8 certain school districts to levy, assess and collect taxes; 9 and making related repeals," in senior citizens property tax and rent rebate assistance, further providing for 10 11 definitions. 12

- "Claimant." A person who files a claim for property tax 1
- rebate or rent rebate in lieu of property taxes and: 2
- (1) was at least 65 years of age or whose spouse, if a 3 member of the household, was at least 65 years of age during 4 a calendar year in which real property taxes or rent were due 5
- (2) was a widow or widower [and was at least 50 years of 7 age] during a calendar year or part thereof in which real 8
- property taxes or rent were due and payable; or 9
- (3) was a permanently disabled person 18 years of age or 10 older during a calendar year or part thereof in which the 11 real property taxes or rent were due and payable.

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 14
