- The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6
- hereby enacts as follows:
- Section 1. Section 1123(c) and (e) of Title 64 of the 8
- Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended and the section
- is amended by adding subsections to read: 10
- § 1123. Certification of economic development organizations. 11
- * * * 12
- (c) Requirements. -- The guidelines must, at minimum, set 13
- requirements for annual training and professional development 14
- for an organization's professional staff, set standards for the 15
- organization's facilities and technical capabilities [and], 16
- require the organization to adopt a code of ethics[3] and 17
- establish annual performance review standards and performance 18
- incentive payments. 19

- 1 (c.1) Annual training and professional development. -- A
- 2 certified economic development organization shall provide no
- 3 less than six hours of annual training in financing per year for
- 4 the organization's professional staff. The authority may
- 5 establish additional training and professional development
- 6 requirements and an approval process for the annual training and
- 7 professional development requirements specified in the
- 8 <u>quidelines under subsection (c).</u>
- 9 (c.2) Performance review standards. -- The performance review
- 10 standards established by the authority under subsection (c)
- 11 shall evaluate, at a minimum, the following:
- 12 (1) The quality of applications underwritten, packaged
- and submitted to the authority by the certified economic
- development organization during the prior year.
- 15 (2) The performance of the certified economic
- development organization's loan portfolio.
- 17 * * *
- 18 (e) [Approval] Certification. -- If the authority determines
- 19 that the application meets the requirements of the guidelines or
- 20 this section, the authority may, in its sole and final
- 21 discretion, certify the applicant as a certified economic
- 22 development organization.
- 23 (f) Decertification. -- If the authority determines that a
- 24 certified economic development organization no longer meets the
- 25 requirements of the quidelines or this section, the authority
- 26 shall decertify the applicant as a certified economic
- 27 development organization.
- 28 (q) Annual performance review. -- The authority shall conduct
- 29 <u>a performance review for each certified economic development</u>
- 30 organization each year. If funds are available to the authority

1	from interest earned on loans, the authority may provide
2	incentive payments to certified economic development
3	organizations based on the performance review.
4	Section 2. Title 64 is amended by adding a section to read:
5	§ 1126. Annual report.
6	(a) Report requirements No later than October 1, 2023, and
7	each October 1 thereafter, the authority shall publish an annual
8	report.
9	(b) Contents The annual report under subsection (a) shall
10	include all of the following information:
11	(1) For certified economic development organizations, as
12	follows:
13	(i) A list of each certified economic development
14	organization which held a certification during the prior
15	fiscal year.
16	(ii) A list of each organization which received
17	certification as a certified economic development
18	organization during the prior fiscal year.
19	(iii) A list of each organization which failed to
20	retain certification as a certified economic development
21	organization during the prior fiscal year.
22	(iv) A summary of the results of the performance
23	review under section 1123(g) (relating to certification
24	of economic development organizations) for each certified
25	economic development organization during the prior fiscal
26	<u>year.</u>
27	(2) (Reserved).
28	(c) Submission The department shall publish the annual
29	report under subsection (a) on the department's publicly
30	accessible Internet website and shall submit the annual report

- 2 <u>Economic and Recreational Development Committee of the Senate</u>
- 3 and the chairperson and minority chairperson of the Commerce
- 4 Committee of the House of Representatives.
- 5 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
