AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 8 (Boroughs and Incorporated Towns) of the
- Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in taxation and finance,
- 3 further providing for tax levy.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 1302 of Title 8 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding subsections to read:
- 8 § 1302. Tax levy.
- 9 * * *
- 10 (f) Earned income tax. -- Notwithstanding any other provision
- 11 of law, council may, by ordinance, levy and, in accordance with
- 12 this part, provide for the collection of an annual tax on wages,
- 13 salaries, commissions and other earned income of individuals.
- 14 (q) Payroll tax. -- Notwithstanding any other provision of
- 15 <u>law, council may, by ordinance, levy and, in accordance with</u>
- 16 this part, provide for the collection of a payroll preparation
- 17 tax in accordance with the procedures for a city of the second
- 18 class under section 303 of the act of December 31, 1965

- 1 (P.L.1257, No.511), known as The Local Tax Enabling Act.
- 2 (h) Local services tax. -- Notwithstanding any other provision
- 3 of law, council may, by ordinance, levy and, in accordance with
- 4 this part, provide for the collection of a local services tax,
- 5 as defined in section 501 of The Local Tax Enabling Act. The
- 6 <u>local services tax shall be subject to the following:</u>
- 7 (1) Beginning upon the effective date of this paragraph
- and ending December 31, 2024, the local services tax shall be
- 9 no more than \$82 per individual.
- 10 (2) Beginning January 1, 2025, and for each succeeding
- 11 January 1 thereafter, council may, by ordinance, adjust the
- 12 <u>local services tax by an annual factor, which shall be</u>
- determined by increasing the amount under paragraph (1) by
- 14 the percentage change in the Consumer Price Index for All
- 15 <u>Urban Consumers (CPI-U) for the Pennsylvania, New Jersey,</u>
- 16 <u>Delaware and Maryland area. In calculating the adjustment,</u>
- 17 <u>council shall use the most recent 12-month period for which</u>
- 18 <u>figures have been officially reported by the United States</u>
- 19 <u>Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics.</u>
- 20 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
