

AN ACT

1 Amending Titles 30 (Fish), 34 (Game) and 63 (Professions and
2 Occupations (State Licensed)) of the Pennsylvania
3 Consolidated Statutes, in Pennsylvania Fish and Boat
4 Commission, providing for organ and tissue donation; in
5 Pennsylvania Game Commission, further providing for powers
6 and duties of commission; and, in powers and duties,
7 providing for organ and tissue donation.

8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
9 hereby enacts as follows:

10 Section 1. Title 30 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
11 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

12 § 322.2. Organ and tissue donation.

13 (a) Application.--The commission shall ensure that the
14 application system for licenses issued under this title
15 processes requests by applicants to consent to organ or tissue
16 donation and include the following statement on all
17 applications:

18 Anyone can save and heal lives. Yes, I would like to
19 register as an organ and tissue donor.

20 (b) Electronic submission.--The statement under subsection

1 (a) shall include a box that an applicant may check to request
2 inclusion in the national donate life registry. If the box is
3 checked, the commission shall automatically electronically
4 submit the information for inclusion in the national donate life
5 registry.

6 (c) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following
7 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
8 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:

9 "National donate life registry." Any of the following:

10 (1) A tax-exempt, nonprofit donor registry.

11 (2) A donor registry identified by the federally
12 designated organ procurement organizations serving this
13 Commonwealth.

14 Section 2. Section 322(c) of Title 34 is amended by adding a
15 paragraph and the section is amended by adding a subsection to
16 read:

17 § 322. Powers and duties of commission.

18 * * *

19 (c) Specific powers and duties.--In order to administrate
20 and enforce this title, the commission through proper action
21 shall:

22 * * *

23 (14) The following:

24 (i) Ensure that the application system for licenses
25 issued under this title processes requests by applicants
26 to consent to organ or tissue donation and include the
27 following statement on all applications:

28 Anyone can save and heal lives. Yes, I would like
29 to register as an organ and tissue donor.

30 (ii) The statement under subparagraph (i) shall

1 include a box that an applicant may check to request
2 inclusion in the national donate life registry and, if
3 the box is checked, automatically electronically submit
4 the information for inclusion in the national donate life
5 registry.

6 (d) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following
7 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
8 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:

9 "National donate life registry." Any of the following:

10 (1) A tax-exempt, nonprofit donor registry.

11 (2) A donor registry identified by the federally
12 designated organ procurement organizations serving this
13 Commonwealth.

14 Section 3. Title 63 is amended by adding a section to read:
15 § 3107.2. Organ and tissue donation.

16 (a) Application.--The bureau shall ensure that the
17 application system for professional licensure processes requests
18 by applicants to consent to organ or tissue donation and include
19 the following statement on all applications:

20 Anyone can save and heal lives. Yes, I would like to
21 register as an organ and tissue donor.

22 (b) Electronic submission.--The statement under subsection
23 (a) shall include a box that an applicant may check to request
24 inclusion in the national donate life registry, the bureau shall
25 automatically electronically submit the information for
26 inclusion in the national donate life registry.

27 (c) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following
28 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
29 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:

30 "National donate life registry." Any of the following:

1 (1) A tax-exempt, nonprofit donor registry.

2 (2) A donor registry identified by the federally
3 designated organ procurement organizations serving this
4 Commonwealth.

5 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
