AN ACT

- Designating the second Monday in October each year as Indigenous Peoples' Day in this Commonwealth.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Short title.
- 6 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Indigenous
- 7 Peoples' Day Act.
- 8 Section 2. Legislative findings.
- 9 The General Assembly finds and declares as follows:
- 10 (1) Millions of indigenous people inhabited the land
- 11 that makes up this Commonwealth prior to European settlement.
- 12 (2) The Doctrine of Discovery enabled Christian
- explorers to wrongfully seize lands inhabited by indigenous
- 14 people and subjected indigenous people to brutality.
- 15 (3) European exploration and settlement adversely
- impacted indigenous populations, devastated natural resources
- and initiated the slave trade.

- 1 (4) Indigenous people suffered discrimination and 2 oppression as a result of European exploration and
- 3 settlement.
- 4 (5) This Commonwealth exists on the tribal lands of the
- 5 Erie, Haudenosaunee, Lenape, Munsee, Shawnee and
- 6 Susquehannock.
- 7 (6) The Treaty of Shackamaxon between William Penn and 8 the Lenape sought to cultivate an alliance and friendship.
- 9 (7) The Treaty of Shackamaxon was broken within a generation.
- 11 (8) From the early 19th through the mid-20th centuries,
- indigenous children were taken from their homes and sent to
- 13 Indian Residential Schools, such as the Carlisle Indian
- 14 Industrial School, which perpetuated cultural genocide of
- indigenous youth through forced "Americanization" that
- included the abandonment of language, tradition, names and
- 17 identities.
- 18 (9) The Snyder Act of 1924, which gave indigenous
- 19 peoples born in the United States full citizenship, was an
- 20 important step in quaranteeing the right to vote for
- 21 indigenous people.
- 22 (10) It is vital to honor the sacrifice, culture,
- tradition and contributions of the indigenous people of this
- 24 Commonwealth and of North America.
- 25 (11) We must build and strengthen connections with the
- 26 communities and tribes of indigenous people in this
- 27 Commonwealth.
- 28 Section 3. Designation.
- 29 The second Monday in October each year is designated as
- 30 Indigenous Peoples' Day in this Commonwealth.

- 1 Section 4. Construction.
- 2 Nothing in this act shall be construed as requiring an
- 3 employer to treat the second Monday in October as a legal or
- 4 official holiday or to provide paid leave to an employee on the
- 5 second Monday in October solely by virtue of the date being
- 6 designated under this act.
- 7 Section 5. Effective date.
- 8 This act shall take effect immediately.
