AN ACT

Amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in grants to fire companies and 2 emergency medical services companies, further providing for 3 Fire Company Grant Program, for Emergency Medical Services 4 Company Grant Program and for expiration of authority. 5 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 7 hereby enacts as follows: 8 Section 1. Sections 7831, 7832 and 7891 of Title 35 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read: 9 10 § 7831. Fire Company Grant Program. 11 The sum of [\$22,000,000] <u>\$66,000,000</u> of the amount appropriated to the commissioner for fire company grants under 12 section 1799-E of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), 13 14 known as The Fiscal Code, shall be expended for the purpose of 15 making grants to eligible fire companies under Subchapter B 16 (relating to fire company grant program). 17 § 7832. Emergency Medical Services Company Grant Program. The sum of [\$3,000,000] <u>\$9,000,000</u> of the amount appropriated 18 19 to the commissioner for EMS company grants under section 1799-E

of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), known as The
Fiscal Code, shall be expended for the purpose of making grants
to eligible EMS companies under Subchapter C (relating to
emergency medical services grant program).

5 § 7891. Expiration of authority.

6 The authority of the commissioner to award grants under 7 Subchapters B (relating to fire company grant program) and C 8 (relating to emergency medical services grant program) shall 9 expire June 30, [2024] <u>2028</u>.

10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
