The SPEAKER For the information of the members, in your e-mail box is a memo from the Parliamentarian outlining the procedure by which committees will organize, as the good gentleman just mentioned. I know in prior years – and this is for the benefit of the new members as well as those who are returning – we would oftentimes spend time here on the floor gathering in our committees and then adopting the rules with the chairmen and then shifting to the next half a dozen committees or so. One of the things that I have always marveled at is essentially the hard reboot that the legislature does each and every session, because we literally start from the ground up. We, as the elected members of the General Assembly, we meet, we form our rules, those rules then inform how we populate our committees, and it will take sometimes 3 to 4 days before a bill or a resolution that comes from those committees will arrive here on the House floor. That is the normal process, and one that is honored throughout the centuries.

So I appreciate the members' diligence in getting to those committees to be organized so that we can begin the work of the people's business.
