**Act of May. 16, 1857, P.L. 536, No. 592**

AN ACT

Relative to Inquests by Coroners and Justices of the Peace.

Section 1. Number of coroners' jurors

From and after the passage of this act, the number of jurors summoned by coroners and justices of the peace in cases of inquests upon the bodies of deceased persons, as now required to be held by law, shall not be more than six to attend any one inquest. 1857, May 16, P.L. 536, Sec. 1.
