

MUNICIPALITIES AUTHORIZED TO OBTAIN FIRE INSURANCE

Authorizing counties, cities, boroughs, incorporated towns, townships, and school districts to make contracts of insurance with mutual fire insurance companies duly authorized to transact business in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That any county, city, borough, incorporated town, township, school district, or poor district may make contracts of insurance with any mutual fire insurance company duly authorized by law to transact business in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, on any building or property owned by such county, city, borough, incorporated town, township, school district, or poor district.
