

**ABOLISH ASSESSMENT OF VOTERS**  
**Act of May 22, 1933, P.L. 837, No. 145**  
AN ACT

Cl. 25

To abolish the December assessment and registration of voters, and repealing inconsistent legislation.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That the annual assessment and registration of voters in the election districts of this Commonwealth commencing on the first Monday in December, and ending on the sixty-first day before the third Tuesday in February, be, and the same is hereby, abolished and superseded; and that all the duties with respect to such December assessment and registration, or in any way appertaining or applicable thereto, heretofore required of and from the assessors in the various election districts, be, and the same are hereby, abrogated and annulled.

Section 2. So much of section one of the act, approved the twenty-ninth day of May, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-one (Pamphlet Laws, one hundred thirty-four), entitled "An act to amend sections one, two, and three of an act, entitled 'A further supplement to the act regulating elections in this Commonwealth,' approved the thirtieth day of January, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and seventy-four, changing the time and manner of making the registry of voters, and the duties of registry assessors," and of the act, approved the sixteenth day of May, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-five (Pamphlet Laws, seventy-five), entitled "An act to amend sections two and three of an act, entitled 'A further supplement to the act regulating elections in this Commonwealth,' approved the twenty-ninth day of May, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-one changing the time and manner of making the registry of voters, and the duties of registry assessors," and of all other acts, or parts of act, which may be inconsistent herewith to the extent of such inconsistency, be, and the same is hereby, repealed.
