

**GOVERNOR JAMES POLLACK MEMORIAL BRIDGE - DESIGNATION**

**Act of Jun. 15, 1987, P.L. 26, No. 11**

**Cl. 87**

AN ACT

Designating the bridge crossing the Susquehanna River connecting the Borough of Milton in Northumberland County and the Village of West Milton in Union County as the Governor James Pollock Memorial Bridge.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The bridge presently under construction over the Susquehanna River on State Route 642 connecting the Borough of Milton in Northumberland County and the Village of West Milton in Union County is hereby officially designated and shall be known as the Governor James Pollock Memorial Bridge.

Section 2. The Secretary of Transportation shall erect suitable markers to implement this act.

Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
