AN ACT

Amending Title 30 (Fish) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes,  
providing for terms of members of the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat  
Commission.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby  
enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 301(c) of Title 30 of the Pennsylvania  
Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

§ 301. Organization of commission.

\* \* \*

(c) Terms of office and compensation.--The members shall hold  
office for terms of eight years and [may continue to hold office  
for a period of time not to exceed six months or] until a successor  
is appointed and qualified[, whichever occurs first]. A member  
appointed to fill a vacancy for a period of four years or less may  
be eligible for appointment to a full eight-year term. A member  
who serves a full eight-year term or fills a vacancy for a period  
of more than four years shall not be eligible for reappointment to  
the commission until a period of eight years expires. The members  
shall receive no compensation for their services but may be  
reimbursed for travel expenses. When performing any function on  
behalf of the commission or acting within the scope of their  
official duties, members of the commission shall be authorized to  
operate Commonwealth vehicles and watercraft and shall be treated  
as employees of the Commonwealth for the purposes of automotive  
and general liability and the act of June 2, 1915 (P.L.736, No.338),  
known as the Workers' Compensation Act.

\* \* \*

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
