

**CLEMENT J. ROLLING MEMORIAL BRIDGE - DESIGNATION**

**Act of Jun. 10, 2014, P.L. 739, No. 54**

**Cl. 87**

An Act

Designating a bridge on that portion of S.R. 0056 over the Norfolk Southern Railroad and Tenth Street, Seward Borough, Westmoreland County, as the Clement J. Rolling Memorial Bridge.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Clement J. Rolling Memorial Bridge.

(a) Findings.--

(1) Clement J. "Clem" Rolling was a lifelong resident of Seward, Westmoreland County.

(2) During his military career with the Army Air Reconnaissance Unit, Clem Rolling proudly served his country for nearly five years in the Pacific Campaign in World War II.

(3) Clem Rolling was honored by the Seward Volunteer Fire Department in May 2013 for 50 years of volunteer service.

(4) At the time of his death in May 2013 at the age of 94, Clem Rolling was the oldest living veteran in Seward and had received several awards from his community for his military service.

(b) Designation.--The bridge located on S.R. 0056 in Seward Borough, Westmoreland County, over the Norfolk Southern Railroad and Tenth Street is hereby designated the Clement J. Rolling Memorial Bridge.

(c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to traffic in both directions on the bridge.

Section 2. Effective date.

This act shall take effect in 60 days.
