THE ISSUE OF DILAPIDATED HOUSING IN OUR INNER-CITY POOR NEIGHBORHOODS.

THERE IS NO DENYING THE FACT THAT MOST OF OUR INNER-CITY NEIGH-BORHOODS ARE PLAGUED WITH BLIGHTED DILAPIDATED PROPERTIES.

PEOPLE OF ALL ECONOMIC LEVELS ARE LEAVING THESE NEIGHBORHOODS.

THE BRAKE-DOWN IN PUBLIC SAFETY AND CRIMINAL ACTIVITY HAS BE
COME THE PRIMARY OCCUPATION THEREBY CREATING AN EROSION OF THE

TAX BASE.

LET ME MAKE IT CLEAR AT THE OUTSET THAT I AM NOT HERE BLAMING
THE RENTAL HOUSING INDUSTRY FOR ALL OF THESE PROBLEMS. MY ORGANIZATION THE SUMMIT TERRACE NEIGHBORHOOD ASSOCIATION HAS REACHED
OUT TO THE CAPITAL AREA RENTAL PROPERTY OWNERS TO JOIN IN COLLABORATION WITH US AND OTHER GROUPS TO IMPROVE THE HOUSING CONDITIONS IN THESE NEIGHBORHOODS BY CREATING A ARCHITECTURAL
CONSERVATION OVERLY DISTRICT. THIS INITIATIVE CAN BE A WIN WIN
FOR ALL PARTIES.

IF WE WANT RESIDENTS TO HAVE PRIDE IN THEIR NEIGHBORHOODS
WE NEED TO MAKE THEM LIVEABLE. IT IS OFTEN SAID THAT HOMEOWNERSHIP IS THE GLUE THAT HOLDS NEIGHBORHOODS TOGETTER.
THAT IS ALSO OUR BELIEF. THE PROBLEM WITH RENTERS IS THAT MOST
ARE SHORT TERM LEASE HOLDERS WHO DO NOT HAVE THE STAKE IN THE
NEIGHBORHOOD AS LONG TERM LEASE HOLDERS.

THE RENTAL PROPERTY HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION HAVE COMPLAINED ABOUT TOO MUCH GOVERMENT INTERVENTION YET THEY HAVE FAILED TO RECONIZE AND TAKE INTO ACCOUNT THAT THERE ARE SLUM LANDLORDS WHO TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THE LAW AS IT IS CURRENTLY WRITTEN AND CONTINUE TO POLUTE OUR NEIGHBORHOODS WITH BLIGHTED PROPERTIES THEREBY TARNISING THE IMAGE OF THEIR INDUSTRY. AS LONG AS THIS BUSINESS PRACTICE IS ALLOWED TO CONTINUE WITHOUT THE INDUSTRY WILLING TO TAKE ACTION TO CONTROL THE ACTION OF THE SLUM LANDLORDS THERE WILL BE MORE GOVERMENT INTERVENTION. IT IS THE ROLE OF GOVERMENT TO STAND IN THE WELL TO PROTECT THE POOR AND POWERLESS AGAINST THE POWERFUL. SLUM LANDLORDS MUST BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR ACTION TO THE SAME DEGREE OF THE LAW AS ANY OTHER PROPERTY OWNER.

PASSAGE OF THESE BILLS WILL HELP TO CLOSE SOME OF THE LOOPHOLDS
IN THE LAW THAT ALLOW SLUM LANDLORDS TO CONTINUE TO POLUTE
THE NEIGHBORHOOD WITH DILAPIDATED PROPERTY AT TAXPAYERS EXPENSE.
