After reading all the articles in The Daily Item concerning the changes I have made in my office in dealing with property owners who have Escrow Agents, I felt it was "MY TURN" to respond with the truth for my reasons.

I have enclosed for your information a copy of the letter which I wrote and asked to have published in the "MY TURN" column since I knew it was too lengthy for the "Letter to Editor" column in the paper. I was certainly disgusted at how my letter was chopped apart and put in the paper as a "Letter to the Editor" which did not convey all I wished to say. (A copy of what was printed is attached to this letter.) So much for "Freedom of Speech" in the Susquehanna Valley!

I hope you will read the truthful version of my response to these people who would like to run my office when they don't know the first thing about it.

Also for your information: On August 31, 2007, the last day of the discount period to pay taxes, I received a total of 18 letters. Of these 18 letters, 15 were from Escrow Agents. Why? These Escrow Agents had the property owners' money in early July and should have made the payments at that time. Copies of incorrect payments sent in to me are also enclosed for your review.

Pennsylvania House of Representatives Finance Committee Members,

I have been a tax collector since 1998. Prior to that, I retired from the Northumberland National Bank as cashier and loan officer.

I have read House Bill 2091 and feel it is incomplete. It does not address guidelines for escrow agents to follow when paying real estate taxes, but puts the entire burden on the tax collector to accept tax payments without addressing the manner in which they should be submitted.

I have fourteen (14) exhibits for this committee to review, several which illustrate problems that are not addressed by House Bill 2091.

- 1. The Letter to the Editor that I submitted to the Daily Item on September 2, 2007 which explains a policy I adopted regarding payments from escrow agents and reasons for the policy.
- 2. A copy of a payment check and disbursement report from Countrywide Tax Services Corp. This report lists eleven (11) properties and tax amounts all of which were in error. The correct amounts are penciled in to the right of the incorrect amounts. No original tax bills were included.
- 3. A copy of a check and real estate notice from SunTrust Mortgage tax bill was for \$1,644.57; payment was in the amount of \$1,552.47.
- 4. A copy of a Wells Fargo Financial check for \$1,548.00 with "Value America Real Estate Tax Information" showing the amount due of \$1,547.73. No bill was included.

- 5. Copy of a check from Payment Processing Center for \$1,748.69. No documentation was included with this check; therefore I had no way of knowing how to credit the payment.
- 6. A copy of a check and information provided from Chase Home Finance LLC for a payment that did not correspond with any of the taxes due for this property.
- 7. A copy of a check and list of properties from Countrywide Tax Services Corp. Payment of \$9.80 for one personal bill was paid instead of the property's real estate tax. No bills were included.
- 8. Sample of "bill requests" from Wells Fargo Real Estate Tax Service and American Real Estate Tax Service. The property owners should have forwarded the bills to the companies. Property owners have told me that they have submitted copies of tax bills to the companies and companies "lose" them.
- 9. Two letters from the PA Housing Finance Agency requesting bills for various properties because the property owners neglected to send them the original bills. I have no way of knowing if this is the correct mortgage company for each of these property owners since in the past I have received tax payments from more than one company for the same property. The property owner should be responsible for providing the tax bills to the mortgage company. Additionally, one of these bills had already been paid.
- 10. While many mortgage companies have complied with my new policy, I feel this policy would not have become such an issue if David Sinopoli, Shikellamy School District Business Manager had not encouraged non-compliance such as in the Daily Item article, an excerpt being "Mr. Sinopoli said he advised them to pay their taxes in the usual way and assured them there would be no penalties for payments received late.
- 11. Daily Item Editorial with the statement "Shikellamy School District officials said taxpayers should continue making payment as they always have. Further, no resident will be penalized if their payments are late due to their tax collector's decision."

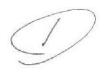

MY TURN...

I am currently serving my third term in office as the tax collector for the Borough of Northumberland. If questioned, I'm confident that all taxing bodies will report to you that my tax deposits and corresponding reports are made on a timely basis. My decision to not accept payments directly from escrow companies was not something arrived at lightly. Due to the many problems with the escrow companies' payments, I implemented a new office procedure: Tax payments from escrow companies are to be sent to the property owner. The property owner may then mail or pay his taxes in person. This enables the property owner to know when his taxes are paid and that the amount being paid is correct. The property owner may also obtain a receipt for his payment. The escrow company's check may be made payable to me if the company is unwilling to make the check payable to their client. Since most property owners also have personal taxes to pay to this office, this should not be an inconvenience to them.

Quite frankly, I find it puzzling that school district personnel, state and local officials, and the editor of the Daily Item are supporting the escrow companies in their efforts to regulate how property taxes are collected.

The explanation in the August 28, 2007 Daily Item Editorial makes tax collecting sound so simple! "As a refresher: With an escrow account, the taxpayer makes a portion of the tax payment each month. At the end of the year, the total payment is forwarded to the tax collector by an escrow agent." This sounds so simple! And if all escrow companies would forward the total payment along with the tax bill, it would be simple! Instead of advocating in your editorial that "controversy illustrates need for reform", why not advocate that all escrow companies should follow the same rules as taxpayers who pay their own tax bills?

I am appalled at the incompetency of some of the escrow agents! Let me describe some of the problems:

- The property owners are to send their tax bill to their escrow agents. But I receive many calls from escrow agents requesting that I send them copies of tax bills. They claim that the property owner neglected to send the bill. However, I have asked several property owners if that is true and in each case was informed that the bill was indeed sent to the escrow companies. Did they lose them or is it just easier for them to call the tax collector instead of searching through their files?
- In past tax seasons, I have provided escrow companies with copies of the tax bills. However, instead of returning each bill with a check for the correct amount, escrow companies will submit a list of property owners with one check for the entire amount. The problems arise when the amount of the check does not equal the amount of the total tax bills for the properties. On August 30th, I received one check from an escrow company for 11 different property owners' taxes. The escrow agent did not include the tax bills. All eleven figures were incorrect. Since I may not accept a partial payment, I must return this check. When the bills

are resubmitted for payment, the discount period will have expired and the face amount will be due. I do not know if the escrow company pays for the mistake made by the escrow agent's incompetence, or if the property owner is charged the additional tax amount.

- Mortgage companies sell mortgages to other companies. I have had more than one escrow agent request the tax amount for the same property. I have no way of knowing which company is the correct one. I have also had more than one escrow company pay the taxes for the same property. By requiring that the escrow company send the check with the bill to the property owner, I know the payment is correct.
- Escrow companies send the checks in all types of mailings. In order to finally get
 to the check, it requires several minutes to wade through the FEDEX envelope,
 bubble wrap and superfluous papers that they submit along with, or instead of the
 required bill and check. It would be interesting to learn who pays the postage for
 this elaborate packaging.

Several years ago, the Shikellamy School district provided the tax collectors with notices to send with every tax bill stating that the tax bill must accompany payment for the taxes. A number of escrow companies did not comply with this request. Instead of enforcing the rule, the Shikellamy Business Manager has backed down and requested that tax collectors deal with payments in whatever manner the escrow companies choose to send them. Why are escrow companies not expected to follow the rules? Tax collectors must provide the school business office with a detailed report, totaling the exact amount of the bills included in the report. This is as it should be. By receiving the tax bill along with the payment, these reports may be completed accurately and in a timely manner.

Every year a number of residents come to me to request copies of paid tax bills for the previous years so they may obtain tax rebates. By submitting the tax payment and receiving a receipt when the bill is paid, they are saved a trip to my office the following year for a receipt.

How many other companies accept one payment for bills from numerous customers, without copies of the bills? Why would the Daily Item call for "reform" instead of advocating that escrow companies be required to submit payment as stipulated? Why should escrow companies be given special treatment?

Escrow companies are not infallible. In the August 17, 2007 issue of the Patriot-News (Harrisburg, PA), Sharon Smith reported that American Home Mortgage filed for Chapter 11 bankruptcy protection. Several tax collectors received checks that bounced. The State Attorney General lacks jurisdiction since the company filed for federal bankruptcy protection.

Why are escrow companies unwilling to send a check to the property owner so he may pay his taxes? Do they really think that the property owner is going to keep the money and let the taxes go delinquent after he has made the monthly payments? And if the check is made out to the tax collector, the property owner would be unable to cash it. Some escrow companies have complied with this new regulation and have sent the tax payments to the property owners. There is no good reason why the others can't do so as well.

Instead of harassing me for doing my job CORRECTLY, the Shikellamy Business Manager, elected officials and the Daily Item should investigate the business practices of these escrow companies in the best interest of the property owners.

Thank you for allowing me to have My Turn.

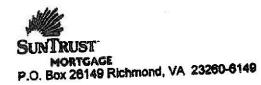

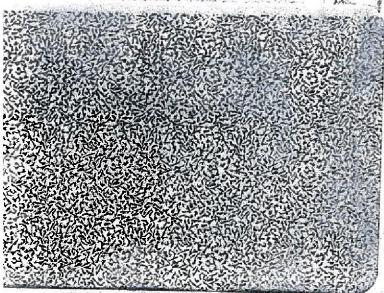

School: No penalty for late taxes

— NORTHUMBERLAND — Taxpayers in the Shikellamy School District will not be subjected to penalties if their taxes arrive late due to the borough tax collector's stance on escrow payments.

Last month, Northumberland tax collector James Snyder decided he would no longer accept real estate tax payments from escrow agents.

Some borough officials said he was having problems with some of the payments he was receiving. However, this caused concern for a number of borough taxpayers. David Sinopoli, Shikellamy's business manager, said the district has received several calls from taxpayers, as well as escrow companies, "wanting to know what to do."

Mr. Sinopoli said he advised them to pay their taxes in the usual way and assured them there would be no penalties for payments received late.

He said the district is "going through some legal channels" to resolve the situation.

"We feel, as a tax collector, he should accept those payments," Mr. Sinopoli said. "We are trying to work toward a resolution. When that's going to work out, I cannot say."

Mr. Snyder met with the Borough Council in executive session following its regular meeting last Tuesday. Though he would not comment further, Mr. Snyder said the purpose of the meeting with the council was to "let them know what's going on."

Council President Bryan Wolfe said the meeting was held behind closed doors because Mr. Snyder's actions "may open him up to legal concerns."

Mr. Wolfe said he doesn't agree with Mr. Snyder's decision because it penalizes the taxpayers and that some other members of council expressed similar concerns.

"Some concern was raised on the taxpayers being hurt," Mr. Wolfe said. "I think it's hurting the wrong people."

But because the tax collector is an elected position, the council is "kind of an outsider here," he said. State Sen. John Gordner, R-27 of Berwick, also questioned Mr. Snyder's policy, but so far has not taken any official action on the issue.

Controversy illustrates need for reform

- James Snyder was elected to collect taxes in Northumberland borough.

He now says he will not collect taxes in some cases. Other officials say they cannot force Mr. Snyder to do his job because he was elected.

Mr. Snyder has reportedly had problems with payments from escrow agents. So he is no longer taking payments that originate from those type of accounts.

As a refresher: With an escrow account, the taxpayer makes a portion of the tax payment each month. At the end of the year, the total payment is forwarded to the tax collector by an escrow agent.

Escrow accounts exist because they are convenient for the taxpayer and the bank. Apparently, they are less convenient for the tax collector.

Borough officials say some escrow agents were sending one check for multiple taxpayers. This was a headache for the tax collector because the lump sum did not always match what the taxpayers owed. One can understand how that would annoy the tax collector. But remember: Collecting taxes is his job.

There was good news Monday. Shikellamy School District officials said taxpayers should continue making payments as they always have. Further, no resident will be penalized if their payments are late due to their tax collector's decision. The implication seems to be that the situation will be resolved without much further aggravation for taxpayers.

But the case illustrates broader problems with the state of local government in Pennsylvania. Jobs that should be done by employees who can be held accountable are held by elected officials who rarely face opposition when running for office.

Until the system is reformed, it will remain difficult to force those elected to obscure offices to fulfill the obligations of their positions.

While Mr. Sinopoli is not guaranteeing that payments will be accepted upon this first submission he continues working with the School District solicitor and plans on identifying the lost interest / lost discount that the tax collector, James Snyder, is creating with this situation and via legal channels attempt to hold him financially accountable.

Taxing Authority Updates (Weekly Tax Update)

Officials at the Shikellamy School District/Northumberland Borough (370496021) are still working to resolve the dispute resulting from the tax collector's refusal to accept tax payments from mortgage lenders. The Shikellamy School District Business Manager confirmed to First American the following:

- Taxpayers with escrow mortgages have been advised by the school district not to pay taxes individually, but to wait for the anticipated resolution with the collector.
- The school district guarantees that the discounted amount will be honored no matter when the issue is resolved.
- The school district has initiated legal action against the collector to accept escrow tax payments remitted by lenders.
- E Lenders should withhold their escrow tax remittance for this agency until the issue is resolved.

In light of the controversy, lenders may choose to remit their escrow tax payments in an attempt to formally fulfill their fiduciary obligations, but should be aware that they may be rejected by the collector. However, First American recommends that those who do so, then fully document the transaction in the event of legal action by the Shikellamy School District Administration.

The dispute began with a recent policy implemented by the tax collector to refuse tax payments from escrow agents; First American has been in direct communication with the Shikeliamy School District Business Manager, who has agreed to rescind the policy. Tax notices issued by this particular collector state that any lender direct payments will not be accepted and that mortgagors must, "get your money from your Escrow Agent to pay your taxes." However, the School District authority (as opposed to its appointed collector, James Snyder) has indicated that it will be revised, and that they will order tax payments to be accepted, or they will establish an alternative collection process in accordance with Pennsylvania statute.

First American will continue to work with the tax authority and is coordinating an appropriate response to the collector. Revised payment procedures will be disseminated in upcoming editions of the Weekly Tax Bulletin, or via a Flashline. Bravo, taxman

When we bought our first house in Texas back in 1990, our mortgage company failed to pay the property taxes the first year. We received a notice from the county that the taxes were overdue and a penalty was owed. We had to argue with the mortgage company to be sure the penalty would not come out of our escrow account as it was their fault for not making the payment on time. After that first year, we always paid the property taxes directly and sent the receipt to the mortgage company for reimbursement. We paid our tax bill early to get the discount. We have a mortgage now, but the taxes are not escrowed—a requirement when we shopped around for a loan.

Over the years, friends and coworkers have complained that their mortgage company also pays their tax bills late — or never. This appears to be a widespread problem.

Mortgage companies have an ethical obligation to act in their client's best interest and pay the taxes early. This is called fiduciary responsibility.

When mortgage companies screw up, borrowers get a lot of grief but are powerless to alter the situation because they signed on to the escrow arrangement. However, local taxing authorities -- like Northumberland borough -- have no contractual agreement with any mortgage company. Given a choice, why allow yourself to be victimized by another's incompetence? If all tax collectors followed Mr. Snyder's lead, mortgage companies would have to shape up.

I hope when you review these documents, you will see that this issue is more complicated than simply requiring tax collectors to accept tax payments from escrow agents.

My recommendation is that you add the following statement to this bill:

"Escrow agents are required to submit an original tax bill with payment to the tax collector. The tax bill should be obtained from the property owner." Penalties should be established for any escrow agent who fails to comply with this provision.

Please consider all of the issues and this recommendation before you finalize House Bill 2091.
