Community solar, as defined in HB 531, is the best way to make affordable solar energy accessible to all Pennsylvanians. By enabling Pennsylvanians to share the energy produced from a large system, community solar eliminates current barriers and brings down the cost of solar, giving consumers additional choice. Currently 70 percent of Pennsylvanians cannot access solar energy due to shady roofs, they may rent, or may not have access to financing. Community solar would expand access and allow all Pennsylvanians the opportunity to subscribe to solar energy systems.

Community solar is also a powerful job creator and can be a critical part of Pennsylvania's economic recovery in the wake of the coronavirus pandemic.

- Creates opportunities for **ALL** Pennsylvania residents to **choose** solar energy.
- Allows low and moderate income citizens, renters, and those unable to install solar energy on their own homes or businesses the choice to participate in Pennsylvania's growing solar marketplace.
