Statement of Ted Leonard Executive Director, Pennsylvania AAA Federation On Digital/Mobile Driver Licenses Tuesday, February 13, 2024

Chairman Neilson, Chairman Benninghoff, members of the House Transportation Committee, thank you for the opportunity to provide input on the subject of Digital/Mobile Driver Licenses.

AAA supports the further development of digital or mobile driver licenses which can be accessed through a mobile device and contain all of the information a traditional license, as a complementary option to physical licenses.

AAA encourages the further testing of mobile driver licenses through pilot programs and encourages states to share their findings.

If a state implements a mobile driver license program, AAA recommends the following features and component:

- 1. Ease of use
- 2. Ability to process information in an acceptable amount of time
- 3. Remote management of the license by the Department, including real-time changes in privileges
- 4. License holder ability to selectively authorize the release of information depending on the party requesting it (i.e. police officer, waiter, rental car company, etc)
- 5. Specific limitations on the use of information scanned from the driver's license
- 6. Privacy and security of the data
- 7. Functionality in an offline environment
