AN ACT

Amending the act of July 2, 1984 (P.L.553, No.110), entitled, as reenacted and amended, "An act establishing a program within the Department of Commerce to provide grants to engineering degree-granting schools to assist in the acquisition of new engineering equipment or the upgrading of existing engineering equipment that is necessary to provide students with the courses required to obtain a degree in engineering," further providing for reallocation of unused funds and for the expiration of the act.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Sections 3(d) and 6 of the act of July 2, 1984 (P.L.553, No.110), known as the Engineering School Equipment Act, reenacted and amended July 9, 1987 (P.L.211, No.35), and amended July 11, 1989 (P.L.318, No.53), are amended to read: Section 3. Engineering equipment acquisition and upgrade.

(d) Distribution of unused funds.—Any allocated funds which have not been expended consistent with subsection (c) by June 30, [1989] 1992, shall be available for reallocation by the board.

Section 6. Expiration.

This act shall expire June 30, [1990] 1993. Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
