A supplement to the act, entitled, An act to establish a Board of Wardens for the Port of Philadelphia, and for the Regulation of Pilots and pilotages, and for other Purposes therein mentioned.

Section 2. Compensation for piloting unregistered vessels owned by citizens

The compensation to pilots for conducting ships or vessels, which are not registered, but which are the sole property of a citizen or citizens of any of the United States, shall be the same that is paid for registered vessels of similar draught of water, whether such unregistered vessel is inward or outward-bound from or to the port of Philadelphia. 1804, April 2, p.l. 470, 4 sm.
