

OFFICERS OF LAND OFFICE TO ACCEPT RETURNS OF SURVEYS

Act of Feb. 20, 1819, P.L. 72, No. 46

A SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled, an act to authorise the officers of the land office to accept returns of surveys and direct patents to issue where an excess of more than ten per cent is returned.

Section 1. Surveyor General to receive returns of surveys made, without issuing warrants of acceptance

The Surveyor General be authorized and required to receive returns of surveys made, or to be made in pursuance of the act to which this is a supplement, without the issuing of warrants of acceptance for that purpose. 1819, Feb. 20, P.L. 72, 7 sm.1. 153, Sec. 1.

Section 2. Patents on titles originating before July 4, 1776, to be accepted

Nothing in this act, or the act to which this is a supplement, shall prohibit the accepting of surveys or the issuing of patents, on titles originating before the fourth day of July, 1776, and which are protected by the act, day of July, 1776, and which are protected by the act, (sections entitled "an act for vesting the estates of the late proprietaries of Pennsylvania in this Commonwealth," passed November 27, 1779. 1819, Feb. 20, P.L. 72, 7 Sm.L. 153, Sec. 2.
