PATENTING OF LANDS - EXTEND PROVISIONS Act of Apr. 5, 1832, P.L. 277, No. 117 AN ACT

Further to extend the provisions of "An act relative to the patenting of lands," passed the eighth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-nine.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That all the provisions of the act entitled "An Act relative to the patenting of lands," passed the eighth day of April, Anno Domini, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-nine: And also of the act to extend the provisions of the foregoing act, passed the twenty-first day of March, Anno Domini, eighteen hundred and thirty-one, be and he same are hereby extended, and shall continue in full force and operation for the term of one year from and after the eighth day of April, A.D. one thousand eight hundred and thirty-two.

Section 2. Purchasers of undrawn donation lots not required to pay interest

The purchasers of undrawn donation lots shall not be required to pay interest on the purchase money on the donation tracts of land, prior to the date of the act authorizing the sale of the said lands or lots, passed March 6, 1813. 1832, April 5, P.L. 277, sec. 2.
