To an act, entitled "An Act to enable the governor to incorporate a company for making an artificial road, beginning at the intersection of Vine and Tenth streets, Philadelphia, and thence to Perkiomen bridge, in the county of Montgomery."

Section 1. Lands held by assignees for benefit of creditors of corporations not to be forfeited

So much of the statutes of mortmain, and of any other disabling laws, acts of statutes, as tends to invalidate the titles to any lands, tenements or hereditaments, in this Commonwealth, now held by assignees or trustees, for the benefit of creditors (of any corporation or corporations chartered by this Commonwealth), be and the same is hereby repealed. 1844, April 19, P.L. 313, Sec. 1.
