To the act, entitled "An Act relating to roads, highways and bridges."

Section 1. Power of quarter sessions to vacate roads
The powers of the Courts of Quarter Sessions of this
Commonwealth, to vacate public and private roads, are hereby
extended to all roads, whether laid out by authority of law, or
existing by prescription or lapse of time; and generally to all
roads, except private roads, resting upon express grant, the
evidence of which is still in existence, excepting in such
counties, as the power to lay out and vacate public roads is, or
may be, vested in some other tribunal, than in the court of
quarter sessions of the peace; excepting, also, roads laid out
by Act of Assembly, and are expressly exempted from the
jurisdiction of said courts. 1846, April 21, P.L. 416, Sec. 1.
