Act of Mar. 24, 1849, P.L. 225, No. 189

A SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An Act to encourage the further development of the mineral resources of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania," passed April eleventh, one thousand eight hundred and forty-eight.

Section 1. Construction of act

The act to which this is a Supplement shall not be so construed as to grant any right or privilege whatsoever, to the surface of the bed of any river; but any rights acquired under said act shall be confined exclusively to sinking shafts and mining beneath the bed of such rivers, after having obtained the right so to do, in the manner provided by said act. 1849, March 24, P.L. 225, Sec. 1.
