

**DELAWARE AND SCHUYLKILL PLANK ROAD COMPANY - INCORPORATED - (REPEALED)**

**Act of Apr. 26, 1850, P.L. 618, No. 364**

**AN ACT**

To vest in Barbara Griffith and Polly Conrad certain supposed escheated personal estate; to incorporate the Delaware and Schuylkill plank road company; and relative to market stalls in the city of Philadelphia.

Section 9. Renters of stalls in markets may authorize others to occupy them

It shall be lawful for any farmer, who is or may be a renter of a stall in any market in the City of Philadelphia, which is or may be appointed to the use of farmers, to authorize any other person (being a farmer) to occupy such stall for the sale of farmers' produce, as fully as he, the said lessee, is authorized to do: Provided, Such lessee shall, when required, make return to the city clerk of all persons who may be renters under him. 1850, April 26, P.L. 618, Sec. 9.
