REAL AND PERSONAL ESTATE - PROTECTION AND ENJOYMENT OF Act of Apr. 6, 1859, P.L. 383, No. 382 A SUPPLEMENT

To an act to amend certain defects of the law for the more safe and just transmission and secure enjoyment of real and personal estate approved twenty-seventh day of April, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-five.

Section 1. Sales of lands by aliens to citizens confirmed In all cases where aliens have purchased real estate within this Commonwealth, and have sold the same to Citizens of the United States, the said sales shall be valid, to all intents and purposes, and shall be construed to vest the title to the said real estate, in the citizens aforesaid, as fully and effectually as if the said aliens had been citizens at the time of purchasing the same: Provided, this act shall not apply to any cases that have already been adjudicated.
