

COMPENSATION OF CHAIN CARRIERS
Act of May 8, 1876, P.L. 136, No. 103
A SUPPLEMENT

To an act, approved the thirteenth of May, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and seventy-four, fixing the pay of road commissioners, road and bridge viewers, and reviewers, and commissioners to run township lines and to divide boroughs into wards, and township lines and surveyors, in this commonwealth.

Section 1. Compensation of chain carriers

From and after the passage of this act, chain carriers employed at the survey of road views and in the division of townships, and running township lines, shall be entitled to one dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50) per day, to be paid in same manner as road viewers and surveyors of same are now paid. 1876, May 8, P.L. 136, No. 103, Sec. 1.
