SHERIFF'S DEPUTY APPOINTED DUTY AT ELECTTION POLLS PROHIBITED IN CERTAIN CASES

Act of Mar. 24, 1877, P.L. 36, No. 30 AN ACT Cl. 25

To prohibit sheriffs in counties co-extensive in boundaries with cities of the first class from appointing any deputies to be present at any election polls.

Section 1. Appointment of deputy sheriffs in certain counties prohibited

It shall not be lawful, on and after the passage of this act, for the sheriff of any county, coextensive in boundaries with any city of the first class, to appoint any deputies to be present and act as such, for preserving the peace or for any other purpose, at any election polls within said cities of the first class. 1877, March 24, P.L. 36, Sec. 1.
