MUSEUM, STATE TO RENT SLIDES Act of May 13, 1909, P.L. 826, No. 644 Cl. 24

AN ACT

To provide an appropriation for a circulating loan collection of lantern slides, in connection with the Division of Education of the Pennsylvania State Museum.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That the sum of four thousand (\$4,000) dollars be appropriated for the purchase of lantern slides of geographical, industrial, historical, and literary subjects, and those representing the fine and useful arts, natural science, and sociology, for circulation within the Commonwealth for educational purposes, under the general direction of the trustees of the State Library.

Section 2. That a general fee of one dollar be charged for each collection of lantern slides loaned, which sum shall be remitted to the State Treasury. This charge shall be made only in cases where transportation is necessary.
